Comprehension Questions (sample answers)

◆ Part 1

1. How long has the writer been in Japan? What sort of work does she do?

She has been in Japan for over two years. / She is in her third year in Japan. She teaches some classes and seminars at and educational center and does visit-teaching at schools in the prefecture. / She teaches at an educational center and also visit-teaches at schools in the area.

2. What does Roy look like? Where is he from?

Roy has long, curly, black hair, dark skin and brown eyes. He is from England.

◆ Part 2

1. What do the students come to tell Roy about?

They come to tell him that his socks don't match.

2. Why do the students look worried for Roy?

They think that Roy has made a big mistake (, and they are afraid he will get in trouble).

Part 3

1. How does Roy respond to the concern of the students?

He smiles and tells them that his socks are matching socks of different colors. He takes off his slippers to show them.

♦ Part 4

1. Did Roy's supervisor finally require him to wear matching socks?

No, she didn't, because she understood his character. / No. Even when teachers complained to her, she still supported Roy because she understood his character.

2. What reason did Roy give to his co-worker for wearing differently colored socks?

To teach his students about accepting differences. / He said that he was using his socks to teach his students about accepting differences between peoples and cultures.
